Garbage Pick-up

Garbage pick-up is Friday. If there is a holiday during the week, pick-up is delayed one day. Things to remember:

1. One large item can be picked up per month per household, call in advance.
2. Carpet can be picked up if it is cut into pieces and bundled.
3. 50lb maximum weight to be handled by workers.
4. No trash is allowed from out-of-Village residents. Violators will be ticketed.
5. Refrigerators and freezers need to be called in before they can be removed.
